## LIMITED REGISTRATION CONTRACT

The following agreement is between \_\_\_\_\_ (breeder), hereafter referred to as "BREEDER/SELLER", and \_\_\_\_\_, hereafter referred to as "PURCHASER".

In consideration of a purchase price of \_\_\_\_\_-hundred dollars, of which one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) is a nonrefundable deposit, the BREEDER/SELLER transfers all rights in fee simple determinable, privileges and responsibilities associated with the ownership of the **female/male** puppy of the Weimaraner breed to PURCHASER as of the date and time specified below with the following conditions subsequent:

PURCHASER agrees to neuter/spay the puppy before it reaches one year of age. PURCHASER agrees to supply BREEDER/SELLER with a veterinarian's letter by certified mail as proof of a neuter/spay. If PURCHASER fails to neuter/spay this puppy and provide proof to the Seller by one year of age, rights and ownership of the dog will automatically terminate and revert back to BREEDER/SELLER who may immediately assume possession of the dog. BREEDERS/SELLERS reasonable attorney's fees for recovery of the dog will be paid by the PURCHASER.

It is understood by all parties to this agreement that this puppy of the above specified description is of pet quality. PURCHASER acknowledges and agrees that this puppy will be registered by limited registration. In the event that the PURCHASER does not have the puppy properly neutered/spayed, any offspring issuing from this pet-quality puppy are **not** eligible for registration with the ABC, AIBC, AKC, or UKC.

The BREEDER/SELLER reserves the right to refuse sale of any of our puppies to anyone. The BREEDER/SELLER will supply up to date health record information, registration application, and a 4-generation pedigree to the

PURCHASER at the time of transfer of said PUPPY. BREEDER/SELLER guarantees the PUPPY to be sound in health and free of any known contagious diseases at time of purchase and upon the PURCHASER receipt of this PUPPY. BREEDER/SELLER guarantees' puppy for 72 hours from when the PURCHASER takes possession of this PUPPY to be in good health. The PURCHASER agrees that during this 72-hour time to have said PUPPY checked by a licensed veterinarian. Should PURCHASER fail to have PUPPY checked by a licensed veterinarian within the 72-hour time this health guarantee is void. If said PUPPY was found to be in poor health, upon written statement from a licensed veterinarian, PURCHASER will have two options.

1. To keep said PUPPY and assuming all costs for its care
2. Return said PUPPY at PURCHASERS expense for a full refund upon the BREEDER/SELLER'S receipt of the veterinarian's written statement

These provisions expire 72 hours from the time the PURCHASER receives said PUPPY in their possessions

The BREEDER/SELLER has vaccinated said PUPPY as required for its age at the time of this purchase agreement

BREEDER/SELLER guarantees' said PUPPY up to 1 year (12 months) from the birth date of said PUPPY for SERIOUS genetic health defects.

#### HEALTH GURANTEEE:

The BREEDER/SELLER agrees to replace said PUPPY with a puppy of equal value within 12 months period ( this 12 months period gives the BREEDER/SELLER adequate time for a new litter to arrive) once they obtain a written and signed statement from TWO Licensed Veterinarians from TWO different vet clinics should puppy obtain the following Genetic Defects:

Failure to receive a passing rating on the hips from Orthopedic Foundation for animals (OFA) or Pennsylvania Hip Improvements Program (PennHip)

They must discover Health Genetic condition due to genetic health problems by 12 months of age from the date of birth of said PUPPY. They must submit this with a written statement from 2 different Licensed Veterinarians from 2 different vet clinics certifying that said PUPPY is suffering from one of the following Thyroid Disease, Epilepsy, Immune Suppressions.

Should said PUPPY be found to have one of the above Genetic Conditions PURCHASER may return said PUPPY to BREEDER/SELLER at the PURCHASERS expense for a replacement puppy of equal value at the BREEDER/SELLERS' discretion.

If said PUPPY has to be put down due to these defects, once a written statement from a licensed veterinarian has been provided.

The BREEDER/SELLER will replace said puppy within 12 months period to give the BREEDER/SELLER adequate time for a future litter to arrive to replace said PUPPY of equal value at BREEDER/SELLER discretion. At this time PURCHASER will return all Registration Papers of said PUPPY to BREEDER/SELLER.

The BREEDER/SELLER makes no guarantees regarding the loss of said PUPPY for an accidental death, theft, sickness due to lack of vaccinations ect. Any sickness not related to genetics as stated above or any loss beyond BREEDER/SELLER'S control. BREEDER/SELLER can not guarantee temperament of said PUPPY once PUPPY leaves the BREEDER/SELLER'S home, the seller has no control over the care, or environment; therefore no other warranties; whether express or implies will be considered.

Also, all of our puppies are started on PURINA PRO LARGE BREED PUPPY and we want you to continue with this food or a PREMIUM LARGE BREED PUPPY formula until the puppy reaches 1 year old. These puppies grow fast and PURINA PRO LARGE BREED PUPPY has the right protein, vitamins, and glucosamine for the fast growing joints, muscles and bones on the large breed puppy. There has been scientific evidence that a generic dog food can cause harmful conditions on the joints and bones of these fast growing puppies. In the event you discontinue the PREMIUM LARGE BREED PUPPY formula before he reaches 1 year old this contract will be null and void.

This sales contract is non-transferable. If PURCHASER relinquishes the ownership of said PUPPY this contract shall be deemed null and void.

#### SHIPPING COSTS:

PURCHASER agrees to pay all costs to ship said PUPPY

1. Crate to ship puppy
2. The total cost of the Air Fare to ship said PUPPY

PURCHASER must have all funds for said PUPPY paid in full to BREEDER/SELLER 10 days prior to shipping. PURCHASER agrees that if funds for shipping and purchase are not received within the 10 days of purchase agreement, unless prior arrangements have been made and agreed by both parties, the PURCHASER will forfeit all rights to the PUPPY and BREEDER/SELLER will retain the deposit fee.

BREEDER/SELLER reserves the right that in the event BREEDER/SELLER should decide to discontinue breeding WEIMARANERS this contract will become null and void.

**When to spay/neuter:** Generally this should be done when the puppy has reached at least 5-6 months for a female and 6-8 months for a male. The older the dog, the more able it will be to withstand the anesthesia. There is no need to wait for a female to have her first heat cycle before she is spayed. In fact, you can avoid the problems associated with estrus by spaying her before it occurs. There is also no need to wait for the male to become sexually mature.

**Why spay/neuter:** Fixing your dog prevents pregnancy and the birth of unwanted puppies. It avoids the need to restrain the dog during estrus. It keeps both sexes from roaming away from your house in search of a mate. It reduces the tendency of male dogs to urinate in the house, marking his territory. Licensing fees are also cheaper. Additionally, it avoids reproductive-related problems such as tumors, pyometra, false pregnancy, prostate infections, and old-age cancers.

**Why should *this* dog be spayed/neutered?** Any puppy sold as a pet should not be bred. This is simply for the improvement and maintenance of the breeding line for Weimaraners. Breeders have striven for years to select and perfect the working ability of Weimaraners. They are bred not only for their high-energy levels, but their responsiveness and intelligence (which is why they have been noted as the most intelligent breed of dogs). Dogs are eligible for a breeding program only if they are able to reproduce either their own quality or better quality in each successive generation. Breeding is not to be done casually nor is it a moneymaking venture. It is not a hobby and is very time consuming and energy demanding. By demanding that this pet-quality puppy be neutered/spayed, it avoids mass-production of average quality Weimaraners, controls the already overblown dog population, and improves the overall fitness of the purebred line.

This does not mean that this puppy is an inferior dog. This puppy is as capable as any of its littermates of becoming a lovable, well-trained, and perfectly happy dog. This does not mean that this puppy will not be able to hunt. At this early age it is very difficult to predict with certainty the potential working ability of any pup. Given the proper amount of love and attention, nothing should prevent this puppy from becoming an excellent companion and family member.
